How would you describe your 35 years of marriage in one word...

As we celebrate God's blessings and His faithfulness over us in the last 35 years of marriage, Rev. Funke and I have everything to be grateful for as He has kept us alive, in health and enjoying His care for us both. The level of understanding, oneness and loving care for one another is remarkable and it is a sign of God's goodness and grace.

What started as an adventure into the life that He has for us, has turned out to be an instrument in God's hands to influence many people to fulfil their destinies in God.

It is hard to describe these years in one word. I would describe it in two words: understanding and love.

In reflecting on your early years of working together in ministry, what are some of your greatest lessons?

One sure word that describes the early days, is wisdom. We read in Isaiah 33:6 (NKJV) that, "Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of your times, And the strength of salvation; The fear of the LORD is His treasure."

From the early days of working together, Rev. Funke and I have been able to recognise each other's strengths and abilities in the work of the ministry, as well as family demands. My wife is more family-orientated; she has helped greatly in the upbringing of the children and maintained the relationships within the family. Her contribution to both family and ministry remains outstanding as she brought in dimensions of relationships to help in every sphere.

We continue to enjoy the different contributions we both bring as we flow in our strengths and abilities.

One: That my husband and I, being two different people and coming from totally different backgrounds (though working towards common goals- success in life, marriage, family and ministry); would naturally have differences in our methods, styles, perspectives, etc. Though our differences were ordained by God, to be complementary to our goals; they could also be problematic, if not handled well.

I learnt you will not always agree, but you can disagree without being disagreeable- you can agree to disagree. You would have to allow the other person handle things differently, and trust their judgment. One of my lecturers in university used to say, "as many teachers, as many methods." I believe that the better idea or method should prevail, even if it comes from "the weaker vessel!"



Two: I realised that separating the domestic roles from work roles could be quite challenging on both sides. You have to be intentional about not wearing the husband/wife hat on the job. For instance, because the Bible says the man is the head of his wife, you might be expected to "submit in everything" to your husband; even folks who should report to you, jump over you to speak to your him! The reporting line and other things tend to be blurred, because you are seen and treated as "the wife of" and not in your official capacity. I used to say that wouldn't be so if I was running my own law practice or even employed somewhere else.

Three: Separating your personal life from ministry. As founders of a ministry, there's a tendency to use every 'dime' that comes into your hands for the ministry. Because you so much want to see the ministry succeed, you sacrifice everything- money, time and energy; which can prove to be very detrimental to your health, family life and other important things in your life.

Though it is very necessary and unavoidable to make sacrifices, they must, however, be reasonable and well-balanced.

Also, not having a demarcation between your money and ministry money, which might have started with a sacrificial motive, could become a major credibility issue as the ministry grows. The Bible says we mustn't let our good be evil spoken of! Four: Maintaining your focus. It's amazing how easy it is to be tempted to copy what seems to be "working" or in vogue- like they say, "if you can't beat them, join them." The Israelites asked for a king, because they wanted to be like other nations. Stay with the vision and the message God gave you, even if it doesn't look popular now: "For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry." (Hab. 2:3).

Five: The influence of third parties- especially the negative influence! People who didn't know how you started and what God told you; would want to determine how you should do things in your ministry. The story of the young and old prophets readily comes to mind. God had commanded the young prophet not to eat bread or drink water or return by the way he came, but he disobeyed God, because he believed the old prophet who claimed he got a contrary word through an angel of the Lord. The disobedience caused the young prophet his life, and needless to say, ended his ministry! (1 Kings 13:11-32).

Six: Another lesson I learnt is that your priorities, desires, concerns, etc; change as you grow older. There were some things that mattered to me in those early year- things I almost regarded as 'deal-breakers'; but no more now. I even often say to myself (like my daughter would say), "Funke, it isn't that deep." That was why I described my first 35 years of marriage, as evolving! The apostle Paul said, "When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child. But when I grew up, I put away childish things." (1 Cor. 13:11 NLT).

How have you been able to juggle it all? How have you been able to attain balance both on the home front and in ministry?

Rev. Funke's contribution to both the home and ministry has helped me appreciate the need for balance. She has been very supportive, understanding and helpful in so many ways. She has encouraged me to give expression to my callings and gifting. She combines a prophetic calling with a pastoral heart. Her leadership skills are awesome. I have witnessed how she balances her work on the home front, and in ministry. She is indeed a gift from God to me, to the people we reach out to in our churches, and in the ministry. Our differences have worked out well for us as we both enjoy the freedom to express ourselves in our gifting and callings: accepting one another, loving and honouring one another, and allowing ourselves to give expression to our gifts and callings. All these have made us a good team both in family life as well as in ministry.

The first thing for me was to identify all the important aspects of my life- my relationship with God, my marriage, my kids, ministry, other important relationships in my life, etc; and not to drop any of them. I also identified my general well-being was very key to achieving success in all these aspects. I was determined not to succeed at the expense of any important things in my life. God gave Joshua the formula for "good success" (Josh. 1:8); which implies not all success is good!

Understanding that life is in phases, and recognising the phase I was in at every point in time. The phase would determine what is given top-most priority and attention. Though I never abandoned any area of my life, they didn't get "equal" attention. For instance, when the kids were little, they needed more attention. Understanding that not everything can wait; your relationship with God can't wait- you must maintain daily fellowship with God, no matter how busy you are! Your spirit man needs to be fed, just as your physical needs physical food for development and sustenance. Your kids will not be little forever, you must be there for them now. I remember when I had to supervise their homework; when I had to make my girls' hair; when I had to cook their meals; going on family breaks during the school half-terms; etc; those times couldn't wait, they had to be seized. Now that I don't have to do all those things, I can give more attention to the other things.

I always ask God for wisdom to handle things. Wisdom is the right application of knowledge. Paul, in praying for the Colossians, said, "that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;" (Col. 1:9c-10). So, it isn't enough to know God's will, you also need His wisdom to do the right thing at the right time- there is a time to everything and God makes everything beautiful in its time (Eccles. 3:1,11).

What would you say are some of the things you enjoy about working together?

Acknowledging the help of God through His grace multiplied, has enabled us to enjoy both family and ministry together.

I believe that going through these lessons are important in enjoying the benefits of working together:

- being able to recognise each person's strengths and contributions and letting them function in those areas for the benefit of all.

- understanding how each person functions and creating room for the expression of their strengths and abilities.
- understanding the limitations of each person's strengths and encouraging them to maximise their potential.

It is important to build on each other's strengths; do your best to make that strength operate at its best possible level. Knowledge of each other's strengths is a very important tool in working together. Knowing your own strength will also help you to develop capacity for more effective contributions to the overall success of your relationship.

In spite of the challenges; I can say there are quite a number of gains from working together! Here are some of them:

One, being able to have ample time together. You know how often you get to see your work mates!

Two, having more common grounds of fellowship. Three, being also able to share each other's challenges and being able to give meaningful support to each other. Four, we can also stand in for each other. For instance, if either of us had a preaching engagement outside the church; the other person would be in church. We actually avoid being away together for too long.

What could you share with those just starting out and/or desire to work together as husband and wife?

Anyone who desires to work together in ministry as husband and wife, should first of all be sure that God is leading them to do so. It is important to have mutual love and respect for each other's callings. Understand that gifts and callings need time to develop into mature expressions. The genuineness of individual callings becomes vital.

There is always the temptation to build ministries according to some existing patterns; whereas God may be leading towards a unique pattern. Rev. Funke and I discovered this in our own lives and ministries.

Challenges do occur as a result of individual differences. The differences in nature, nurture and culture need to be identified. In my experience, it is our love for God and for one another, and our willingness to learn, adjust and rise up to challenges, that has helped us to come this far, to the glory of God! There are sacrifices we have made, risks we have taken and steps of faith and boldness at both personal and family levels. God has been faithful to see us through.

The truth is you should be supportive of your spouse- even if you are not in ministry yourself. If I was still in the Law practice, I would have still been involved in the ministry but not as I am now. I don't believe every pastor's wife should necessarily be a (full-time) pastor; just as not every pastor's child is called to be a pastor!

Having said that, now to answer the question:

One, you must first ascertain if you should be working together in the first place! That you're married doesn't automatically mean you should work together. I tell people that I am not doing what I do, because I'm Rev. Kola's wife; but because I am called. My husband and I have a unique relationship- divinely orchestrated for a purpose. We started "working together" even before we got married! We were already in a relationship when God called him into full-time Ministry; so I knew I was getting married to a minister. I remember him telling me that he had always known (even before we ever met), that his wife would stand "side by side" with him in Ministry!

Then, you must identity your own unique gifts and calling, so you know what roles you should be playing in the work. You're meant to complement each other- each person supplying what the other doesn't have, to enhance the work. You're meant to complement and not to copy; to complement and not to compete.

Two, work hard on keeping your marriage and family strong. Doing ministry together could put extra pressure on your marriage; because it's quite hard to separate the home from the Ministry! There's that tendency to bring ministry challenges into your home; also, many church members don't respect the pastor's privacy. Be loyal to each other- you must choose each other above church members; let them know your marriage comes before the Ministry. Learn to value and express appreciation for each other's contributions.

Don't be so engrossed in Ministry work, that you neglect each other and your family. So, try to keep Ministry away from home; plan get-away times together from time to time; and be intentional about putting your family above Ministry. Avoid being away from the kids together for long; the kids shouldn't be "robbed" of their parents. I remember Gloria Copeland said she wasn't travelling around with Kenneth when the kids were still little. Ruth Graham was mostly with the kids when Billy was travelling to one crusade after the other! I am not, however, by any means suggesting or implying that the job of parenting should left solely to the wife!

You both must realise that your family is the first expression of your Ministry. From the start of Ministry, I was determined not to neglect my family- after all, charity begins at home! The Bible says, "But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever." (1 Tim. 5:8); also a man who doesn't govern his house well, can't govern the church (1 Tim. 3:5)!

Three, don't let Ministry take the place of God in your lives; a lot of ministers have mixed up the two. Ministry should flow out of your relationship with God. When Jesus called His 12 disciples, the Bible is clear about the order of their appointment or assignments: "Then He appointed twelve, that they might be with Him and that He might send them out to preach, and to have power to heal sicknesses and to cast out demons:" (Mk 3:14-15). They were appointed first to be with Him, before being sent out! Mary sat at the feet of Jesus listening to His words, while Martha was busy with serving. The Bible actually says, "Martha was distracted with much serving," (Luke 10:40b). Be careful not to allow ministry (service) to become a distraction!

Four, (which is closely tied to no. 3); you mustn't forget to pay attention to yourself; Ministry should be an overflow of your life. Paul told Timothy, "Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you." (1 Tim. 4:16). Ministers are influencers in the society; therefore what you do, as well as what happens in your life and family, could have ripple effects. Jesus warned, "If anyone causes one of these little ones—those who believe in me—to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea." (Matt. 18:6 NIV). No wonder, James 3:1 says teachers would be judged more strictly!

Make sure you're not just preaching to others, but you're also practicing what you preach- that is actually what gives authority and power to what you preach. Have you noticed that being a medical doctor, doesn't automatically keep you from falling sick yourself; except you also do what you advise your patients to do?

Philippians 2:13-15 (NKJV)

"for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure. Do all things without complaining and disputing, that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world..."

This passage captures my expectations for the next phase of our marriage. We shall continue to enjoy His good pleasure in our marriage and continue to shine as lights in this world. I pray that God will do exceedingly, abundantly, above anything that I can ask or think for the next phase of our marriage.

This next phase is also a phase of full expressions in maturity and understanding. We look forward to causing great impact in the lives of people as we see God's kingdom advance in the nations of the earth. The sincerity, integrity and hunger for God's Word and intimacy with God's Spirit, all go a long way in the impact that God has used us to make in the lives of people. Our motivation has not been showmanship or self-gratification, but rather that God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven. We continue to cooperate with the Holy Spirit within us to give expression to His plans and purposes for the people we have had the privilege of leading, influencing and building up.

As we have matured our understanding of the Word of God also matured in us. Then I better understood this scripture:

Ephesians 4:11-16 (*NKJV*)

"And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ— from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love."

These gifts and callings did not manifest fully at the beginning of the ministry. It was as we matured, rising up to the challenges we faced and seeing God's goodness and grace pouring forth into our lives, that we saw Him confirm His Word with signs following. We are still learning, growing and becoming more like Christ as we do the will of Him who called us.

Romans 8:28-30 (NKJV)

"And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified."

We look forward to doing greater works too!

John 14:12-14 (NKJV)

Funke welcomed their first baby, Samuel Kolawole Oluwapelumi, after which Rev. Funke felt the call to leave her law practice and join her husband, Rev. Kola, in fulltime ministry. They were further blessed with two more babies - Morenikeji Ruth and Joanna Kanyinsola.

God has used Rev. Kola and Rev. Funke Ewuosho to raise an Apostolic centre, the Word of Faith Christian Centre (in Kano, Nigeria), from which many ministries and churches have sprung out. Honestly, I was very disappointed. I confided in the leaders at Ignite (our student ministry at Harvestime Church) and I prayed with my mum. At this point in time Pastor Funke was delivering her message, 'How to Plead Your Case'. He gave me the strength and determination to create a well put together presentation in under 24 hours and memorise my notes.

The next day I went to Savills HQ and presented my work. I told God this was all for His glory and asked if He would use my experience as a testament to His goodness. After all the students had presented and the decisions had been made, my name was called out as the winner for first place. I won the largest cash prize as well as a 4-week paid internship! I'm so grateful to God for allowing me to partake in the competition and for sending Pastor Funke to teach and guide me in how to grow as a young Christian woman. I'd like to encourage you not to accept 'mistakes', as God makes no mistakes! Commit all your cares to God and He will take care of you.

Going through Process ...

to the glory of my Father in heaven and to the encouragement of my family from Him.

As I look back to reflect on some parts of my journey with Him I can see His hands on every single detail, be it small or big. It includes the times when I didn't really know Him; I only believed in Him religiously, as a distant entity.

I first visited the UK as a 15-year-old student. I heard an inner voice saying I would return to the UK, but I didn't quite understand. I didn't know anything about the prophetic at the time. 14 years later, on 29th August 2006, I relocated to the UK. I was only in the country for 3 days when a colleague, namely Phumzi, invited me to Harvestime Church, and since 3rd September 2006 the rest is history!

My grandma taught me to pray at the age of 5 and answered all my questions. She explained that that I am talking to God and although I cannot see Him with my natural eyes, He does see me. At Harvestime Church I realised that God not only sees but hears and answers the prayers of His people.

I have been receiving from and growing spiritually at Harvestime Church, thanks to the Word of God and the prophetic teaching by Pastor Funke and Reverend Kola; so that I may know what to do with the prophetic, how to apply it to get victorious results, and how to overcome the power of the enemy, Satan himself. In the summer of 2012 Reverend Kola led me in the prayer of salvation so that my soul may not perish. At an Encounter Night on the 25th March 2014, I received the gift of tongues by a brother laying hands on my forehead. I was baptised with water on the 18th April 2014. In 2015, I heard Reverend Kola saying that he wasn't saved just for religious activities but for something great. I thought to myself, how about me? I finally realised that I should look to God to answer my questions. He is the creator and owner of the plan, so I began to seek Him even more seriously. One day some time in 2015, I woke up saying I must go to the world to preach the Gospel. God gently told me: "Let Me heal you first." In order to hear from Him, all the junk had to go from my mind, from my heart and from my body too. I also had to learn to be quiet and still before Him and listen to what He has to say. I went through a deep healing and restoration process, which is another testimony.

In May 2016 God inter-connected me with a ministry where they equip Holy Spirit Evangelists and send them out to the mission field. By that time I understood from the Word that before reaching out to Judea and Samaria and the ends of the earth, I needed to start in Jerusalem which is my own family. God lovingly and mercifully used me to lead my earthly father to Christ before passing away 2 years ago and he did the same for my stepfather before his death 10 months ago. Prior to this I had to go through a whole process of forgiveness to be able and to be available as a vessel for God. Amongst these, the greatest miracle for me was leading my mum in the prayer of salvation 2 years ago after a life time of addiction to alcohol, and the healing of my brother from brain tumour. Other testimonies also encouraged my faith, and I responded to an opportunity to train and develop further at an Evangelism Bootcamp overseas. God is faithful to continue the work He has begun in me.

May Jesus receive the reward for His suffering even unto death for eternal life.

May Pastor Funke and Reverend Kola receive theirs for the labour of their love, and everyone at Harvestime Church too.

May my life count even unto death, as long as the Gospel is preached.

Throne Room Concert is an annual event organised by the Tabernacle of David (TOD) Choir, a ministry under the auspices of Word of Faith Christian Centre (WOFCC)

in Lagos, Nigeria. This event is an integral part of the Fountain of Wisdom Ministries.

Our overarching vision is to pioneer a paradigm shift in worship, ushering in a new era of devotion as prophesied in Amos 9:11-13. Since its inception in 2012 (first known as 'TOD Concert'), the event has evolved into what is now

Additionally, we take the opportunity to showcase the extraordinary talents of our inhouse anointed music ministers. This year, we were privileged to have Odunayo Adebayo, a prolific songwriter known for compositions such as 'ZOE' and 'AYO DE', grace us with his presence. Some of the in-house ministers we featured include Minister Anny, Yinka Noiki, Mnena Sadiku, and Fiyinfoluwa Ogunnaike (Fofo), not to mention our Teens choir. The impact of all the ministers' contributions remains indelible in our lives.

The Throne Room Concert of 2023 stands as a testament to our unwavering commitment to excellence in worship and the profound influence it wields on the spiritual landscape.
